Vision for Balanced Economy


The challenge – Estonia lacks a common vision for sustainability.

% and **Action Plan 2040.**

The pulp - Concept for **Balanced Economy**.

Surface of the apple - vision and new green narrative for Estonia.





Green Tiger Energy Roadmap

- Estonia relies on fossil sources of energy. Renewable energy has the lowest footprint and is the cheapest form of energy.
- Estonia needs **2000 MW windfarms** (currently 320 MW) and **1300 MW solar parks** (currently 500 MW). Need for energy storage and controllable power around 2000 MW.
- Energy saving is an important focus.
- **Meed for dispersed electricity production.**



Roadmap for construction


- One of the root issues of Estonian cities is car-centric city planning.
- Focus on renovation: an important means for higher energy efficiency, job creation and supporting new businesses.
- Low Carbon Construction: not enough know-how, innovative public procurement and data access.





Goal 2040: 85% less CO₂

Graph: carbon emissions of construction and building material production (tons of CO₂)





Transportation roadmap

One of the core challenges of Estonian transportation is car-based urban planning.



- Priority on public transport network and active means of transport (e.g. biking)
- The need to create **prerequisites for electrification** of means of transport
- Support the logistics sector in transfer to zero-emission cargo-hauling













